Did you know...

- Feb 27th to March 11th is **Fairtrade Fortnight** when people throughout the community, from schools to mosques to churches to libraries and many more, make hundreds of fairtrade drinks and sell lots of fairtrade goodies to encourage everyone to get the message about fairtrade. ASDA would like to help Oadby & Wigston – if you're involved in fundraising for an Oadby or Wigston charity which specifically helps local people (rather than as a local part of a national/regional campaign) or your community groups supports local people, ASDA is keen to help. Their community champions can offer: free use of their training room (upstairs with lift access) for meetings or drop in information sessions for the public – education in local schools (healthy eating, fairtrade, recycling, etc) – volunteers to help with gardening, decorating etc. – running information & activity stalls at community events – in-store fundraising through bag packing (you supply the bag packers!) or with a specific campaign (e.g. linked to needing funds for treatment for a sick child). It's worth bearing in mind that their national guidelines say that they can't get involved with fundraising for political & military groups; single religious or ethnic groups who are simply fundraising to further their own specific faith or ethnic values; sponsorship of events/activities; charity advertising; overseas charities. To help record the work they do a letter of thanks from any organisation receiving funds/support would be a great help and would make their work more sustainable.

Do your facilities need a facelift? Have an outdoor area that needs some 'oomph?' Are you a charity or voluntary/community group that needs some practical help? We are seeking Team Challenges - practical projects that can be completed in a day – for our teams of business volunteers to tackle. Examples of Challenges include indoor projects such as giving a tired, well-used room a 'makeover' and lick of paint, and outdoor challenges such as helping create a garden area or clear woodland in a nature reserve. In most cases Team Challenges provide 'volunteer power' for a project, however some teams may also have access to resources to help complete a challenge. (Please note that Team Challenges cannot accommodate technical, structural or construction work). Most businesses encourage general 'team-building' activities amongst their employees. Team Challenges are a great opportunity for such activities as well as a chance for staff to give something back to their local community, have a positive impact on an organisation or area, and leave something sustainable behind.
